One of the things we try to do more of during Lent is **PRAYER**.

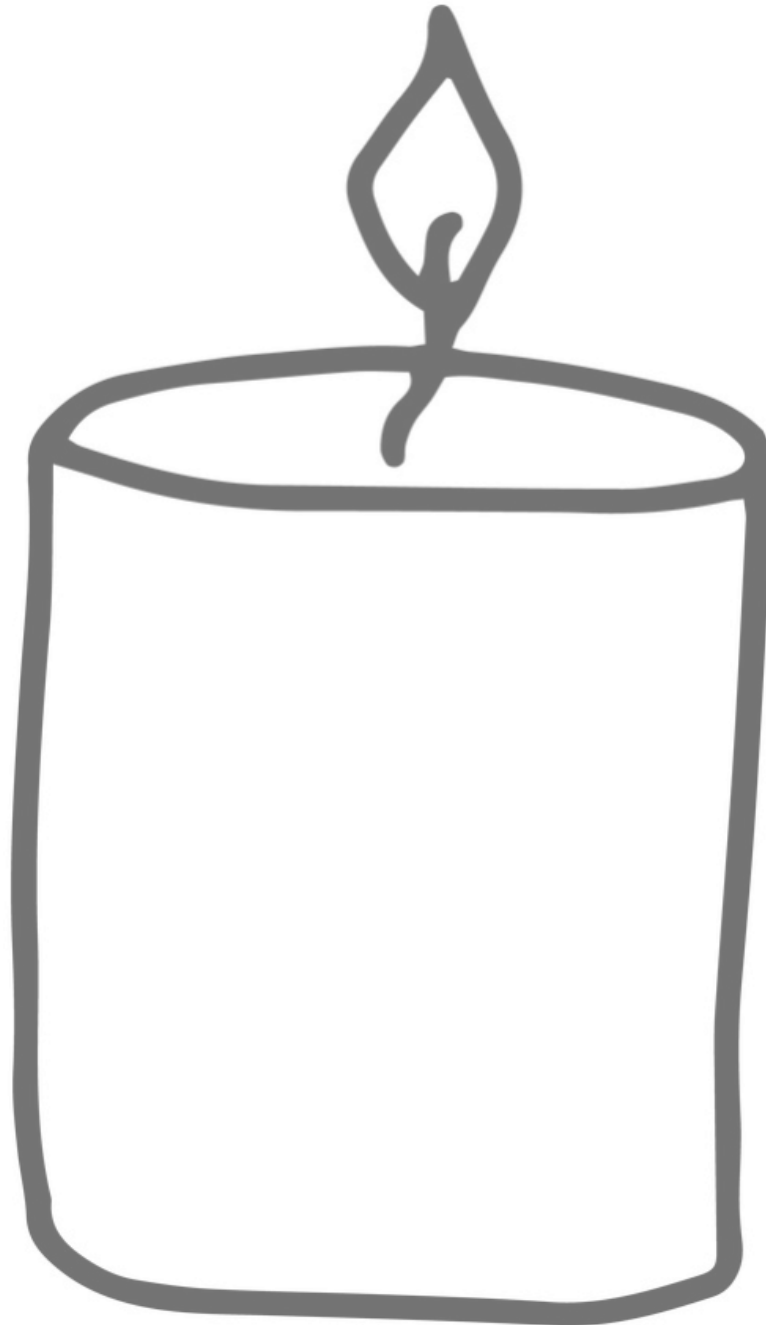
Listen for all the times we pray together today and circle ○ them on your guide.
