**Ascension Day Eucharist -** Heavenly Rest will celebrate Ascension Day on Thursday, May 26th, with a service of Holy Eucharist at 7:00 p.m. Ascension Day is the occasion on which the risen Christ is taken into heaven after appearing to his followers for forty days (Acts 1:1-11, Mk 16:19). The Ascension marks the conclusion of Jesus' post-resurrection appearances. It is the final elevation of his human nature to divine glory and the near presence of God. The Ascension is affirmed by the Nicene and Apostles' Creeds. The Ascension is celebrated on Ascension Day, the Thursday that is the fortieth day of the Easter season. It is a principal feast of the church year in the Episcopal Church.

**Final Wednesday in Eastertide -** Next week, we will have opportunities for hands-on creation care activities that focus on repurposing, reusing, and recycling. Join us for our final Wednesday night during Eastertide as we reflect on our role in caring for creation and consider our responsibility to love as God loves.
