Lent is the time of the color PURPLE.
Write or draw where you see PURPLE in
worship today.

Today is the first Sunday in the season of **LENT**, the time to get ready to enter the great Mystery of Easter.

There are 40 days in Lent, not counting the Sundays.

The color for Lent is PURPLE. It is the color of kings and Jesus is King of our hearts, but not the kind of king that people thought he would be. Lent is a serious time because something serious happened to Jesus the King.

It is also a time to pray, to think about things that we are sorry for and ask for forgiveness, and to give ourselves and our gifts to God in a new way. BEGIN by praying and listening to God every day this week, by yourself and with your family. You can use your Family Scratch-Off Prayer Calendar to pray together.
