Our Sunday Worship – the Holy Eucharist – has a pattern that is the same each week. The first part is the time when God’s people are **COMING TOGETHER** and the second is **LISTENING AND LEARNING**. We are on the third part, **PRAYING AND SHARING**.

PRAYING AND SHARING includes: “Prayers of the People” and the “Confession of Sin and Pardon.”

Next is “**Passing the Peace of Christ.**” Because we have confessed our sin and know that we have been forgiven, we should be full of God’s love and peace, so we take a moment to share it with those around us. We say “Peace”, “God’s Peace be with you!”, “The Peace of the Lord”, or something like that to share that peace with others.
